1	Neck	Pain and stiffness - worsens with head and arm movement Pain scale: 7/10 medications: cyclobenzaprine, Ibuprofen	<p>Diagnosis: Acute neck pain post MVC, Sprain of ligaments of cervical spine Cervical disc disorder at C5-C6 level with radiculopathy Cervicalgia</p> <p>Findings: Pain scale: 7/10, Tender to palpation on cervical and lumbar regions, mild degenerative disc disease to lower cervical spine</p> <p>Radiological findings: X-ray- Degenrative changes with no acute findings MRI of cervical spine- Mild degenerative disc desiccation C2-3 through C6-7, C5-C6: Mild posterior disc bulge, C6-C7: Posterior disc protrusion</p> <p>Treatment: Chiropractic therapy Physical therapy</p> <p>Pain Medications</p>	On 03/28/YYYY, The symptom was exacerbated or worsened by rest lying down and lifting (Pdf ref - 1160).
2	Right ankle and knee pain	Patellar fracture of right ankle , right knee injury - due to MVC in 1997	<p>Diagnosis: Strain of other muscle(s) and tendon(s) at lower leg level, right leg, sequela (right tibialis anterior tendinopathy)</p> <p>Findings: Moderate, well localized, tenderness to palpation present around the anterior and lateral regions of the ankle, around the lateral side of the ankle and over the anterior talo-fibular ligament (anterolaterally)</p> <p>Diagnostic imaging: MRI of Right ankle: Occult non-displaced fracture of the navicular bone of the mid foot Talonavicular and talocalcaneal joint DJD (Degenerative Disc Disease) Mild chronic plantar fasciitis</p> <p>Treatment: Pain Medications</p>	On 03/28/YYYY, injuries sustained to the right ankle knee, although she had pre-existing the injury from a patellar fracture. And right now she is having symptoms in the right ankle. Locking sensation pain which patient reports an acute flare up that took place (pdf ref: 1160)
